- It can be florals and leaves, or you might choose repetitive and geometric – it is YOUR design, you decide.
- You have to finish it neatly and well. You will be making this into your own clay tile next lesson.

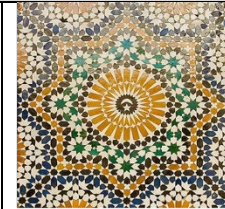
### Task 3

- You may use plasticine, playdough to create your design.
