- You have to finish it neatly and well. You will be making this into your own clay tile next lesson.

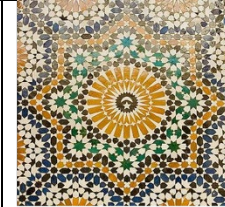
Task 3
