**This term we are doing a project on Portraits and Cubism.**

In this project you will learn:

1. How to draw a portrait from different angles using line.
2. About Cubism and how you can use similar ideas in your own portrait work
- 3 To design and create your own Cubist image.
4. How to build a collagraph printing plate
5. How to print a collagraph print.

**For your first lesson you should create 3 x 6mins timed drawings.**

Take 3 pieces of paper and ON ALL of your pieces of paper write your FULL NAME and your group

You need to find someone to draw, your mum/brother/carer, etc (if you can use the images provided).

Looking carefully and draw the person opposite you using line only and not taking your pen or pencil of the page unless you have to. This is called **Contour drawing** and is a drawing exercise to help you to focus on looking properly.

They should look a bit like these ones:

One from the front, one from the side (profile) and one from ¾ side.



Consider the following:

- Draw each of them as big as you can within the A4 page.
- Add your name, surname and class code to your artistic sketch drawings.


- Keep the drawings safe and bring them to school on your return.
