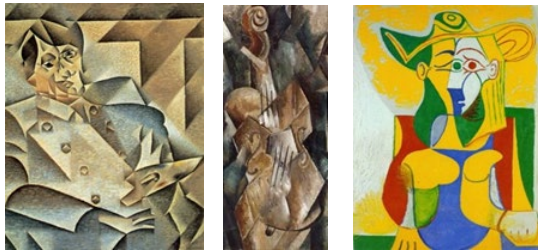

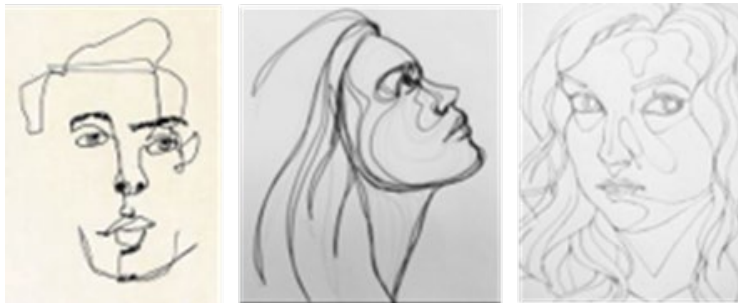
This term we are doing a project on Portraits and Cubism.

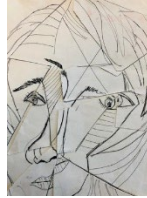

Include the neck and shoulders if you have space.
