- 1 Find out what foreground, midground and background means in a landscape.
- 2 Copy: **Composition** is the arrangement of elements within a work of art.
- 3 Task:
You are going to create your own landscape showing clear foreground, midground and background, using colour and mark making like you have used in previous lessons. You should show your understanding of composition, colour mixing and mark-making.

Look at this example by David Hockney:




It can be as colourful as you want,
It should have: foreground, midground and background.
It should have mark making.
You can use any technique you may have at home, paint, watercolours, pencils, felt-tips, coffee for painting, etc.
