Create some quick drawings of the room or building where you are at the moment. 10 min, 3 drawings. 2. Now create a mixed media responses to the work of Ben Boothby from your own drawings. You can overlap images/ different perspectives. Don't use more than 3 types of colours eg you could use red orange and green and different versions of those colours. 3.
