

# Sixth Form Home Learning Programme

All students are expected to continue to follow their personal timetables. Directed work for each timetabled lesson will be set by their class teacher on the appropriate day using ClassCharts. Students are expected to log on to ClassCharts every day. ClassCharts will also be used to direct students to the 'P' Drive (student shared drive) or Sharepoint where further lesson resources and revision materials will be stored to support their learning. They are expected to try their best to complete all the work set.

In addition to the normal scheduled lessons, students will be set further independent study which should be completed after each lesson. We appreciate these are very challenging times but ensuring students stay focused and continue to work hard is important for their next stages of learning.

***We appreciate that exams are not happening in May/ June for Year 13 however we hope that students continue to complete the work set by the school. It is possible that the work set will be needed to prepare for any exams that students may choose to sit in Autumn 2020 and Summer 2021, so please encourage students to complete it, and keep it organised and safe as we may need to request it back at short notice. As we get more information, we will adapt the tasks set to best support the students to prepare for their qualifications.***

Parents and carers are asked to support in ensuring Sixth Form students focus on their academic studies throughout the school day. It is vital that students continue to complete their own independent study to build upon directed lesson content, as they would when in school. We ask that parents and carers check that students have completed all the work set and have returned it to their teacher or saved it onto their 'P' drive where requested.

## How much work should a Sixth Form student be completing?

On average, a year 12 student should be completing a minimum of:

- ✓ 15 hours of directed lesson work, published on ClassCharts each week\*
- ✓ 15 hours of independent study, published on ClassCharts

On average, a year 13 student should be completing a minimum of:

- ✓ 15 hours of lesson work, published on ClassCharts each week\*
- ✓ 15 hours of independent study, published on ClassCharts

\*On average, students have 30 A-level lessons per fortnight. Some students may have one week which is slightly heavier than the other so the specific amount of directed lesson work may vary between week A and week B.
