

# Year 11 Home Learning Programme

We appreciate that exams are not happening in the summer but we hope that students continue to complete the work set by the school as this will support teacher assessment for qualifications and next learning stages, whether that be in our Sixth Form, at college or in the workplace.

***It is possible that students might wish to sit some of their GCSE exams in Autumn 2020 or Summer 2021, so please encourage students to complete the work set over the next 3 school weeks, and keep it organised and safe as they may need to use it for future revision.***

Students are expected to follow their personal timetables but within the times set out below after logging onto ClassCharts at 8.45am each morning where specific instructions will be given as to what work will be studied each day. They are expected to try their best to complete all the work set.

Each day should start with a short physical warm up. The exercises will be communicated via ClassCharts and we encourage the whole family to engage in them!

Parents and Carers are asked to check that students have completed the work set and returned it by saving on Sharepoint or as directed by their teacher.
