## **Year 9 Home Learning Programme**

Students are expected to follow the timetable below after logging onto ClassCharts at 8.45am each morning where specific instructions will be given as to what work will be studied each day using the online programmes below. They are expected to **try their best** to complete all the work set but we appreciate this may not always be possible.

Each day should start with a short physical warm up. The exercises will be communicated via ClassCharts and we encourage the whole family to engage in them!

Reading should be a mix of silent reading and reading aloud from a 'book' rather than a magazine or comic. Ideally this will be the student's school reading book.

More specific work will be set now from the subjects in the timetable below with instructions given through Classcharts. Students will now focus studies on subjects they are likely to be taking from September 2020.

Parents and Carers are asked to check that students have completed the work set to the best of their ability. Ideally, parents will listen to their children read in some of the reading sessions, test their children on their spellings and check what work has been completed.

Any issues relating to completion of work should be communicated to the child's teacher via email. All teachers' emails are on the school website on the Contact Us tab.

If there are computer / internet access issues, students can collect packs of work to complete from the school but must contact the Head of Year to arrange to do this.

If sharing computer access the suggested timings of the day could be changed to ease such issues
