Subject	What are students learning in lessons?	What are students learning in home learning?
Autumn Term 1	Component 3 (Find Me): exploration of how characters from the set text can be played, as well as how scenes can be designed (lighting, sound, set, costume, hair and makeup).	1 hour per week: exam questions on current topics in lessons/previous topics.
Autumn Term 2	Component 2 (Script Work): preparation and rehearsal of short performances that will be performed in front of a visiting examiner.	Minimum of 1 hour per week: line learning and continuation of exam questions.
Spring Term 1	Component 2 (Script Work): preparation and rehearsal of short performances that will be performed in front of a visiting examiner. Component 3 (Find Me): continuation of how Find Me can be acted and staged.	Minimum of 1 hour per week: additional rehearsals and completing exam questions.
Spring Term 2	Component 3 Live Review (Frankenstein): analysis and evaluation of the National Theatre production of Frankenstein.	Minimum of 1 hour per week: completion of exam questions.
Summer Term 1	Component 3: revision of Find Me and Frankenstein. Revision and exam preparation for GCSE exams.	Minimum of 1 hour per week: exam questions.
Summer Term 2	Course complete.	Course complete.
