Subject	What are students learning in lessons?	What could students do to extend their learning and develop their character?
Autumn Term 1	Greetings and Introductions: name, age, where you live, days, months, numbers, birthdays, giving opinions, free time, activities and weather.	Be curious: research the nationalities and languages of your favourite celebrities.
Autumn Term 2	Family: describing appearance, describing personality, describing family members, describing animals.	Be independent: practise describing people and animals in French whilst out and about. Keep the key words with you in a little notebook to help.
Spring Term 1	School: school subjects and opinions, describing teachers, school facilities, break time activities and food.	Be open-minded: research school timings of Francophone schools. Would you prefer to have any of their rules or routines?
Spring Term 2	School: school uniform, school rules, hobbies after-school.	Be independent: label your wardrobe with French words for each part of your uniform.
Summer Term 1	Where I live: describing my house, describing my town, what you can do in your local area, where you would like to live.	Be creative: make a video in French showing someone around your town. Describe it using vocabulary learnt in lessons.
Summer Term 2	Revision of all units and exam preparation for end of year exams: greetings and introductions, family, school, where I live.	Be independent: revise all units from this year for your end of year exams.
