Summer Term 1	Christianity: Jesus' birth, ministry, death, resurrection and ascension.	Be independent: research some of the churches in your local area and see what they do in the community.
Summer Term 2	Christianity: the beginning of the Church and the spread of Christianity, Catholics and Protestants, sacraments.	Be independent and resilient: revise for your end of year exams.
