Subject	What are students learning in lessons?	What could students do to extend their learning and develop their character?
Autumn Term 1	Holidays: destinations, transport, accommodation and activities.	Be ambitious: plan a holiday to a French speaking country including, activities, accommodation and transport.
Autumn Term 2	Holidays: your usual holidays, describing a holiday in the past, ideal holidays.	Develop confidence: practise your key tenses and vocabulary by creating a timeline for a holiday with descriptions.
Spring Term 1	Going out and Staying in: free time activities, favourite TV show, films and music, planning an event, inviting people to your event.	Be curious: find out what the top TV shows and films are in France and other Francophone countries. Watch some episodes of appropriately aged shows.
Spring Term 2	Health and fitness: describing your routine, healthy and unhealthy lifestyles, resolutions for healthy living, at the doctor's.	Be independent: draw and label a skeleton poster with body parts in French.
Summer Term 1	School and Future Plans: school facilities, school rules and opinions, jobs and responsibilities.	Be curious: research jobs in the UK that require a second language.
Summer Term 2	Revision of all units and exam preparation for end of year exams: holidays, going out and staying in, health and fitness, school and future plans.	Be independent: revise all units from this year for your end of year exams.
