Subject	What are students learning in lessons?	What could students do to extend their learning and develop their character?
Autumn Term 1	Working with the theme of 'Natural Forms': recording observations in different media, drawing using different materials.	Be creative: make studies using any materials of natural forms.
Autumn Term 2	Natural Forms: Research and respond. Use Peter Randall Page and a variety of ceramics artists to inspire designs for ceramics.	Be creative: collect images of natural forms and 3D artwork inspired by them.
Spring Term 1	Natural forms colour and painting: focus flowers and plants.	Be proactive: research more artists that you could use to inspire your own, more personal, design ideas.
Spring Term 2	Flowers / Natural forms with a focus on colour. Pencil, paste and paint work. Focus artist is O'Keeffe.	Be creative: Use air drying, clay/ blue tack/tin foil - anything you can find, to create a 3D form.
Summer Term 1	Either - Group Project: Use of and exploration of line & stylisation of natural forms and portraits using pens & ink on a large scale inspired by Lucy McLaughlan. Or - GCSE style project: Everyday objects / Food: record ideas through a variety of media.	Be curious: research and look at semi abstract art - with a focus on colour.
Summer Term 2	Theme of 'Conflict': develop your own expression of personal ideas through an art style. Pen and ink work. Large scale pieces in inspired by the style of Lucy McLaughlan. OR: Skills: focusing on drawing skills, colour and tin foil sculpture.	Be creative: make an image out of pattern and text that says something about an issue that is important to you.
