Subject	What are students learning in lessons?	What are students learning in home learning?
Autumn Term 1	Internally Set Assignment 1 (ISA1) Component 1. Everyday Objects: observations, drawing, photography and artists research.	1 - 3 hours per week: continue work from lessons for the ISA.
Autumn Term 2	Internally Set Assignment 1 (ISA1) Component 1: experiment with ideas, media, and processes. Refine ideas through experimentation and complete personal outcome (final piece).	2 - 3 hours per week: continue work for the ISA, experimenting with and refining ideas from lessons, and work on final piece.
Spring Term 1	Internally Set Assignment 1 (ISA1) Component 1. Reflections: portraits / reflections / abstraction / abstract work based on water / bubbles. Independent student choices.	2- 3 hours per week: continue work for the ISA, extending and adding to work in more depth.
Spring Term 2	Internally Set Assignment 1 (ISA1) Final Piece: experiment with previously explored media and ideas, annotate, reflect and refine ideas, then create the personal outcome (final piece).	2 - 3 hours per week: continue work for the ISA, developing and refining ideas and techniques.
Summer Term 1	Internally Set Assignment 3 (ISA3) Component 1: Year 10 exam project based on the theme 'Gatherings'.	2 - 3 hours per week: continue work for the project outside of lessons.
Summer Term 2	Internally Set Assignment 3 (ISA3) Component 1: experiment with previously explored media and ideas, annotating, reflecting and refining ideas, then creating the personal outcome (final piece) in 5 hours of controlled time.	2 - 3 hours per week: continue work for the project outside of lessons.
