Subject	What are students learning in lessons?	What are students learning in home learning?
Autumn Term 1	Organisation: tissues and organs, digestive and respiratory systems, enzymes, food tests, heart, blood and blood vessels.	45 minutes per week: Sparx science on previous topics. 15 minutes per week: paper task for retrieval practice or exam practice.
Autumn Term 2	Organisation: tissues and organs, plant tissue, transpiration and translocation. Communicable Disease: infectious diseases caused by viruses, bacteria, fungi and protists, immune response.	45 minutes per week: Sparx science on previous topics. 15 minutes per week: paper task for retrieval practice or exam practice.
Spring Term 1	Communicable Disease: vaccination, antibiotics and painkillers, drug discovery, monoclonal antibodies, plant diseases and defences.	45 minutes per week: Sparx science on previous topics. 15 minutes per week: paper task for retrieval practice or exam practice.
Spring Term 2	Non-Communicable Disease: lifestyle factors, coronary heart disease and treatments.	45 minutes per week: Sparx science on previous topics. 15 minutes per week: paper task for retrieval practice or exam practice.
Summer Term 1	Bioenergetics: aerobic and anaerobic respiration in plants, yeast and animals, human response to exercise, photosynthesis, factors that affect the rate of photosynthesis. Cells revision: types of cell, cell cycle, transport in cells.	45 minutes per week: Sparx science on previous topics. 15 minutes per week: paper task for retrieval practice or exam practice.
Summer Term 2	Revision and exam preparation for end of year exams. Ecology: ecosystems, sampling techniques, effects of humans on the environment, adaptations, food webs and pyramids of biomass, how materials are cycled, food production.	45 minutes per week: Sparx science on previous topics. 15 minutes per week: paper task for retrieval practice or exam practice.
