Spring Term 1	Germany (Paper 3, code: 33): 1918-1923 challenges faced by the government and people of Germany after World War Two.	1 hour per week: knowledge recall and exam questions on previous topics.
Spring Term 2	Germany (Paper 3, code: 33): 1924-1933 the rise of the Nazi Party and reasons why Hitler became Chancellor in 1933.	1 hour per week: knowledge recall and exam questions on previous topics.
Summer Term 1	Life in Nazi Germany 1933-9 (Paper 3, code: 33): women, workers, young people and minorities.	1 hour per week: knowledge recall and exam questions on previous topics.
Summer Term 2	Superpower Relations and the Cold War (Paper 2, code P4): 1941-56 including the breakdown of the Grand Alliance, the Berlin crisis 1948/9, the creation of the Satellite States in Eastern Europe and the Hungarian Uprising.	1 hour per week: knowledge recall and exam questions on previous topics.
