Subject	What are students learning in lessons?	What could students do to extend their learning and develop their character?
Autumn Term 1	Impressionism: study Monet's painting techniques, develop different brushstroke skills and colour mixing.	Be curious: find out more about Impressionism. There are Monet works in The National Gallery. Write a report about it.
Autumn Term 2	Impressionism: paint an Impressionist style painting from a photograph. Colour mixing and brushstroke techniques in the style of the Impressionists.	Be responsible: take photographs of interesting scenes or objects. Annotate the photos to suggest colours & techniques that could be used to paint them.
Spring Term 1	Cubist Portraits: portraits from different angles. Study Cubism and develop a semi abstract design for a collagraph print.	Be focused: practise drawing portraits from different angles and create a gallery page showing your three best portraits with annotations.
Spring Term 2	Collagraph Printing: create cardboard collagraph plate. Create a set of collagraph prints.	Be curious: research Cubism artwork in Tate Britain or Tate Modern, on their websites. Create an illustrated artist poster inspired by the movement.
Summer Term 1	Real to Abstract: draw the school building using line, develop into abstract work inspired by Constructivism.	Be curious: sketch a local building and transform it into an abstract artwork inspired by Constructivism.
Summer Term 2	Abstract Sculpture: design and make. Share and adjust ideas working on a group sculpture. Learn building, cutting and joining skills.	Be resilient: create an abstract sculpture using found objects and document how your design changed during the making process.
