

How to access Bedrock


 To access Bedrock, you should search for 'Bedrock Vocabulary', which will take you to the sign in page.



- On reaching the sign in page, you must make sure the correct tab at the top is selected (either student or guardian/ teacher). Please see the FAQ section for how parents/ guardians can access Bedrock to monitor their child's engagement.
- If your child is logging in to Bedrock, they should now enter their username and password (this information is available from your child's English teacher).



4. Should your child forget their username or password, they can log in by clicking the Office 365 button which will log them in automatically as long as they are signed into a device linked to their school email.



- Once logged in, your child can begin to complete Bedrock lessons as part of their homework. The minimum requirement for homework is that students complete 2 lessons of Bedrock per week. They can complete more- up to 2 lessons per day if they wish.
- 6. Bedrock is broken up into modules (each module contains several lessons within it). You will be able to see completed tasks and not be able to move on to the next module until the current one is completed. See below an example of the modules- these will vary depending on your child's 'Block Level'- please see FAQs for more information on this.
