Getting logged on and completing maths homework

If this is your first-time logging onto Sparx follow these instructions:

How to log in to Sparx - new students

1. Go to sparx.co.uk, click **Log in** and choose **Student login**
2. Start typing the name of your school in the **Select Your School** box, making sure you **click on the correct school name** when it comes up. Click **Continue**.
3. Click the **New User?** button at the bottom of the box.
4. Fill in your **Name and Date of Birth**.
5. Click **Submit**. You will be given a username and asked to choose a password – you must remember it!
6. Click **Finish**. You will be asked to re-enter your username and password. This is to help you remember it.

Now you can log in with your **Username** and **Password** :)



If you have logged in before you should already have your username and password. If you have forgotten this, please click on forgot login details on the Sparx login page.

How to complete your homework:

Once you are logged on using your username and password, you will see your compulsory homework. You must always complete the newest homework first. This is the one at the top of the list and you must do all the tasks in each homework. **You must get 100% of your compulsory and target homework correct to be counted as complete.**



Videos and Seek Help

If you get a question wrong, Sparx will tell you to watch a video and have another try. It is important you watch this as it explains how to do that particular question.

If you get the same question wrong more than 3 times, it will tell you to seek help. Just close the seek help box and then carry on with the rest of your homework. Make a note of the question and bring it to your teacher in your next maths lesson.

Bookwork Checks

In a bookwork check you will have to type the correct answer you wrote down for a particular bookwork code.

If you fail the **bookwork** check you will have to do that question again, so it is important to make sure you write every bookwork code with the answer. You should be doing this in your homework book making sure it is written neatly so you can easily see the codes and answer. Here is an example of good bookwork
