Lesson 1

Continue with the theme of the Still life project from this term. Set a Still life (arrange 3 objects together in a way that looks good), then draw the three objects on an A4 paper.

Consider the following:

- Draw the objects as big as you can within the page.
- Try to draw them in a way that shows which object is in front and which one is behind.
- Add directional shading with a pencil using at least 5 different tones between black and white.
- Take a picture of the objects, so you can complete the drawing on another day.
- Add your name, surname and class code to your artistic drawing.
- Keep the drawing safe and bring it to school on your return.
