Dress Code

The Regis School Sixth Form is committed to raising aspirations and recognising achievement. We expect our students to wear smart attire when attending The Regis School Sixth Form.

Male students and those who identify as male:

Formal trousers.

Formal shirt.

Smart shoes (these include black canvas style shoes) Formal jacket or blazer (optional).

Tie (optional).

Fine knit jumper (optional).

Students who study BTEC Sport or BTEC Sport and Exercise Science are permitted to wear The Regis School Sixth Form PE kit.

Female students and those who identify as female:

Smart trousers, skirt or dress of an appropriate length. Formal top, blouse or shirt.

Smart shoes (these include black canvas style shoes and sandals as long as they have a strapped back) Blazer, formal jacket or smart, fine knit cardigan or jumper (optional).

Students who study BTEC Sport or BTEC Sport and Exercise Science are permitted to wear The Regis School Sixth Form PE kit.

All students:

Coats may be worn to and from The Regis School Sixth Form, but in accordance with school expectations, these must be removed upon entering the building. Outdoor scarves and hats should also be removed upon entering the building.

Sixth Form students are permitted to have facial piercings; however, these should be discrete, and a stud should be worn.

Hair can be dyed, however, it must be of a natural colour.

Students are not permitted to wear any of the following:

- Denim.
- Hooded clothing.
- Low-cut, cropped, strapless or spaghetti tops.
- Shorts (unless worn with The Regis School PE kit- these must be black or navy)
- Leggings (unless worn with The Regis School PE kit- these must be black or navy)
- Sweatshirts (unless this is a part of the Regis PE kit)
- Trainers (unless worn with The Regis School PE kit)
- Headphones and mobile phones, except in 6th Form areas.
