Dress Code

The Regis school Sixth Form is committed to raising aspirations and recognising achievement.

The Sixth Form will act as role models and as examples to the pupils in the school.

The dress code will

- Foster respect for the Sixth Form from staff and other pupils
- Present an image that sets high expectations in the school and the community
- Should not distract from learning or be viewed as offensive, revealing or (sexually) provocative.
- Ensure that clothing is fit for purpose and have regard for Health and Safety.

Student Responsibility

It is each student's responsibility to ensure they are well presented when entering the building. We ask that students dress smartly.

To adhere to our policy, we ask that students do not wear any of the following:

- Sports/gym clothes (unless students are studying BTEC Sport in which case it must be The Regis branded PE kit)
- × Hooded jumpers
- × Ripped clothing
- * Any revealing clothing which is too short or too low, such as cropped or strapless tops
- **×** Beach wear, including flip flops/sliders
- × Hats
- × Any clothing which may have inappropriate wording or images.

Students will be asked to return home and change their clothing should they not adhere to the dress code within our Sixth Form
